

## 2012 ACC Bible Quizzing – The Gospel of John

### Interchangeable Words:

God / the Father

Jesus / Christ / Messiah / Son of God / Son of Man / Jesus of Nazareth / Jesus the son of Joseph

Counselor / Holy Spirit

Devil / Satan

Simon / Simon Peter / Cephas / Peter / Simon son of John

Judas / Judas Iscariot / Judas the traitor

Quizzers must refer to the other disciple Judas as “Judas, not Judas Iscariot.”

Jesus’ disciples / the disciples

A quizzer’s answer “the disciples” can always be assumed to mean “Jesus’ disciples.” Quizzers must say “John’s disciples” when they are referring to John’s disciples.

John (the Baptist)

John the Baptist is not actually used in the text, John the disciple is never mentioned by name in the text, and Simon’s father is always spoken of in reference to Simon. Therefore, a quizzer’s answer “John” can always be assumed to mean John the Baptist, unless the quizzer clarifies otherwise.

man born blind / man blind from birth / man who had been blind / blind man

All refer to the same individual, and no other blind men are mentioned in the book.

### Other notes:

The Word is referred to as “who,” not “what” (because of 1:2). An answer of Jesus will be incomplete.

The true light is referred to as “who,” not “what” (because of 1:10). An answer of Jesus will be incomplete.

“High priest” is incomplete. They must specify Annas or Caiaphas.

“Mary” is incomplete. Quizzers must specify which Mary.
